Day 1 – Monday, March 29 – Flight from Canada to Miami – Marriott Biscayne Hotel (Welcome Reception)

- For those who have purchased Collins Tours' All-Inclusive Air & Transfers Package, you will depart the Maritimes on your scheduled flight, enroute to Toronto, where you will meet your tour manager. The group will pre-clear US Customs in Toronto before boarding Air Canada flight for Miami. (Airfare + 1st piece of checked luggage + 1 carry-on bag included with package).
- **NOTE: 1st checked piece of luggage is free (up to maximum of 50lbs). 2nd bag is an additional cost and based on weight. Additional fees apply for overweight and oversized bags. Carry-on luggage is free; your bag must be light enough that you can store it in the overhead bin unassisted and typical weight is a maximum of 22lbs per carry-on bag.** Visit www.aircanada.com for more details on luggage fees. - Welcome to Motril, a town that offers a relaxed coastal atmosphere, but the real highlight lies just inland. From here, it is an easy drive to Granada, one of Spain's most captivating cities. Granada blends Moorish history, Spanish tradition and vibrant street life in a way that feels almost magical. The crown jewel is the Alhambra, a palace and fortress filled with delicate arches, carved stonework and peaceful courtyards framed by fountains and gardens. Standing on its terraces, you can look out toward the Sierra Nevada and understand why generations have been enchanted by this place. Whether you choose to explore Motril's gentle seaside or venture into Granada's rich heritage, this port offers a day filled with beauty and culture.
- Our ship will sail this evening for Cartagena.

Day 17 – Wednesday, April 14 – Cartagena, Spain (B, L, D)

- Today, we are in Cartagena, Spain from 9:00am – 7:00pm
- This fortified city has long played an important role as a naval port thanks to its sheltered bay and strategic position. Take in the sweeping hilltop outlook from Concepción Castle, a site once controlled by the Carthaginians, Romans and several later powers. Explore the Roman Theatre dating back to the 1st century B.C., along with the remains of the 13th-century Cathedral of Santa Maria and the engaging Naval Museum. If you enjoy early 20th-century design, look for the striking modernist style of the City Hall, the Grand Hotel and the historic Casino.
- Our ship will set sail this evening for Valencia.

Day 18 – Thursday, April 15 – Valencia, Spain (B, L, Group D)

- Today, we are in Valencia, Spain from 7:00am – 7:00pm



- Your ship arrives in Valencia, a city that blends centuries of history with a bright, modern spirit. Its old town is one of the largest in Spain, filled with lively squares, medieval streets and landmarks that reflect its Roman, Moorish and Spanish heritage. A short distance from the centre, the striking City of Arts and Sciences highlights Valencia's innovative side with its futuristic architecture and impressive cultural venues. For something more traditional, you can visit the Lladró City of Porcelain to see how their world-famous pieces are crafted by hand. Along the waterfront, long sandy beaches and a relaxed Mediterranean atmosphere invite you to slow down and enjoy the coast. Whether you

choose history, modern design or fine craftsmanship, Valencia offers a colourful and rewarding day ashore.

- Tonight, join your tour manager and fellow passengers this evening for our last group dinner on the ship before we continue our adventure in Catalonia's capital city. We will also discuss details of our disembarkation tomorrow and our next adventure ahead.
