Day 1 – Monday, May 24 – Overnight flight to Athens, Greece

- For those who purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air, you will depart from your local airport and meet the Tour Manager and your fellow travellers at Toronto airport for group flight to Athens Airport, Greece. All passengers are flying on Air Canada flights. **PLEASE NOTE: Each passenger has 1 piece of luggage up to 50 lbs each bag, included in the Collins Tours Inclusive Airfare Package. Additional pieces of luggage may require fees paid directly to the airline. Fees will be charged on both the outbound and return flights if applicable.** Be sure to have your ***valid passport** for Customs & Immigration which you will clear in your final destination, Athens, and **not** in Canada.

Day 2 – Tuesday, May 25 – Athens, Greece at 5-Star Athens Marriott Hotel (Welcome Reception)

- Arrive in the Athens airport. After clearing Immigration, we proceed to the baggage carousel to collect luggage and meet our private deluxe motorcoach for transfer to our hotel. Please collect your luggage and do not leave the baggage carousel without your Tour Manager. Once we meet our coach, your luggage (1 piece per person) is looked after and will be delivered to your hotel room upon check-in later this afternoon.
- We check into the 5-star Athens Marriott hotel. Please note: We will be arriving in the morning and while an early check-in request has been made, hotel rooms are not guaranteed until 3:00p.m. Your Tour Manager will handle check-in, pass out room keys, and have luggage delivered to your rooms once available. If rooms are not ready, the Athens Marriott hotel is located on the bustling artery of Syngrou Avenue, within walking distance of the Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Centre and the Athenian Riviera. Enjoy their signature spa treatments, take a seat in the Great Room or the outdoor Atrium and relax into the chic urban setting. Surround yourself with impeccable views on the E&O Rooftop in your hotel while relaxing with a cocktail and savouring delicious fusion cuisine.
- Take time to freshen up before our “Welcome Reception” inside our hotel including a glass of wine or beer and light appetizers - a chance to meet your fellow traveling companions **(included)** and have a brief introduction from your Tour Manager.
- Dinner this evening is on your own with plenty of options just steps away from our hotel.



Day 3 – Wednesday, May 26 – Athens (B, Welcome Dinner)

- Wake up and enjoy a delicious full breakfast buffet this morning **(included)**.
- This morning, we welcome our local guide for a tour into to the heart of Athens. We will ascend to the summit of the Acropolis and stand in the shadow of the mighty Parthenon, the best example of classic architecture of the 5th century BC. Other stops include Dionysus Theater, Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Panathenaic Stadium (where the first modern Olympic games were held 1896) and the Memorial of the Unknown Soldier for the changing of the guards. We will see the Trilogy of Athens and ascend Mount Lycabettus Hill (the highest point in Athens) for unparalleled views and excellent photo opportunities. We drive through Plaka, the oldest neighborhood in Athens, where you can wander and peruse local shops with handmade crafts and gifts. We will make a stop for lunch as we tour this ancient city (lunch not included).
- This evening, please meet your Tour Manager and join your fellow Collins Tours group passengers for a welcome group dinner at a local restaurant served with wine or beer **(included)**. We will share stories together and discuss further details of our amazing experience through the Mediterranean!



Day 4 – Thursday, May 27 – Athens – Mykonos, 5-Star Myconian Avaton (B, Group D)

- Enjoy another full buffet breakfast this morning **(included)** before departing to make our way to the airport to catch our flight to the beautiful island of Mykonos (**Intra island flight from Athens to Mykonos is included in your land package**)
- After a short flight, we check into the luxurious 5-star Myconian Avaton Resort, perched above the Aegean with breathtaking views. Your Tour Manager will check you in and assist the hotel with luggage handling.
- The Myconian Avaton is a stylish and thoughtfully designed luxury property set on the hillside above Elia Beach. Built into the natural rock landscape, this hotel combines traditional Cycladic architecture with contemporary design.
- You will have exclusive access to a private section of Elia Beach (one of the best beaches in Greece!), complete with complimentary sun chairs and umbrellas throughout your stay at this resort. It is the perfect spot to relax by the sea, take in the views, and enjoy the laid-back atmosphere of one of Mykonos' most beautiful beaches!
- This evening, please meet your Tour Manager and join your fellow Collins Tours group passengers for a group dinner at a local restaurant served with wine or beer **(included)**.

Day 5 – Friday, May 28 – Mykonos (B) – Included Group Excursion

- Dinner this evening is on your own.

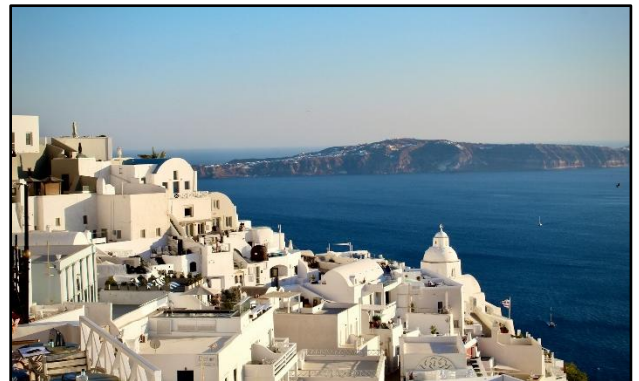
Day 7 – Sunday May 30 – Mykonos (B, Group D) **Optional Excursion: Delos Island Guided Tour**

After a short boat ride from Mykonos, explore the fascinating ruins of this uninhabited island, once a thriving cultural and religious centre of the ancient world. Our expert local guide will walk us through highlights such as the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Terrace of the Lions, the ancient theatre, and the remarkably preserved houses and mosaics. With sweeping views and rich mythology, Delos offers a memorable glimpse into Greece's ancient past. After the guided portion, enjoy a bit of time to explore or take photos before returning by boat to Mykonos. **(Price TBD)**
- This evening, please meet your Tour Manager and join your fellow Collins Tours group passengers for a group dinner at a local restaurant served with wine or beer **(included)**.



Day 8 – Monday, May 31 – Mykonos – Ferry to Santorini, 4.5-Star Santorini Palace (B)

- Enjoy your last buffet breakfast in Mykonos this morning before check-out **(included)**.
- This morning, we depart Mykonos and travel by ferry **(Ferry included in land package)** to the breathtaking island of Santorini. Sit back and enjoy the scenic journey across the Aegean Sea as we make our way to one of Greece's most iconic destinations, known for its dramatic cliffs, whitewashed villages, and stunning caldera views. Please note you will be required to handle your own luggage when boarding and disembarking the ferry as there are no porters available.

Upon arrival, we will transfer **(included)** to our beautiful 4.5-star hotel, the Santorini Palace, one of the most prestigious hotels on the island. Time to settle in before beginning our time on this unforgettable island. Your Tour Manager will check you in and assist the hotel with luggage handling.
- Our hotel is located only a few meters away from the cliff of the Caldera and the panoramic view of the volcano which offers a combination of beautiful Cycladic architecture, open spaces and proximity to interesting sites.
- Dinner this evening is on your own.



Day 9 – Tuesday, June 1 – Santorini (B, Group D)

- Enjoy your first Santorini buffet breakfast at the hotel **(included)**.
- Today is yours to enjoy at leisure. Take full advantage of the resort's beautiful setting and amenities as you

Highlights include the royal apartments, grand courtyards, storage rooms, and colourful frescoes that reveal what life was like during the Minoan era. After our guided visit, we will travel into Heraklion, where you will have some free time to explore the historic centre, browse local shops, or relax at a café before returning to our resort. **(Price TBA)**.

Day 15 – Monday, June 7 – Rhodes (B) Rhodes City Tour Optional Excursion

- Enjoy another fabulous buffet breakfast this morning at the hotel **(included)**.
- This morning, join your Tour Manager and fellow travellers for an optional half-day excursion as we discover the rich history of Rhodes Old Town, one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Accompanied by a knowledgeable local guide, we will explore the narrow cobbled streets, historic squares, and impressive stone buildings that date back to the time of the Knights of St. John, who ruled the island in the 14th and 15th centuries. Highlights include a walk along the famous Street of the Knights, lined with the former residences of the knightly orders, and views of the magnificent Palace of the Grand Master, a striking fortress that once served as the administrative centre of the Knights. Along the way, our guide will share stories of Rhodes' fascinating past while you take in the atmosphere of this remarkable walled city. There will also be some free time to browse local shops, enjoy a café, or continue exploring before returning. **(Price TBA)**.
- Dinner this evening is on your own.

Day 16 – Tuesday, June 8 – Rhodes (B, Farewell D)

- Enjoy another fabulous buffet breakfast this morning at the hotel **(included)**.

- Canadian citizens are required to have a valid passport that is good for at least **THREE MONTHS BEYOND** your departure date. Citizens of other countries should call and verify their required documentation.
- **Baggage allowance details:** For all Air Canada flights to and from Europe: You are allowed one personal and one carry on item at no charge (max dimension 23 cm x 40 cm x 55 cm). You are also allowed one free checked bag (max weight 23 kg; \$100 fee for overweight bag).
- Duty Free Rules allow you to claim \$800 per person.
- Airline fees for any checked baggage overages or additional bags (both outbound and inbound flights) are **NOT** included in your tour package, and any additional costs are your responsibility paid directly to Air Canada.
- All liquids/gels you plan to bring on board an airplane must be 3oz or less and sealed in a Ziploc bag. Once at the security checkpoint, this bag must be removed from your carryon & placed in bin for TSA screening.
- Prescription medication should be kept in original container or carried with you during travel.
