Conclude this exciting adventure with two post-cruise nights in the heart of London! We have assembled a detailed daily itinerary for you to review.

Day 1: Monday, June 14 – Canada Flight to Reykjavik, Iceland

- For those who have purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air Package, make your way to your local area airport for your assigned flight connecting in Montreal/Toronto to your overnight Air Canada flight to Reykjavik, Iceland. **NOTE: 1st checked piece of luggage is free for international flights (up to maximum of 50lbs). 2nd bag is an additional cost and based on weight. Additional fees apply for overweight and oversized bags. Carry-on luggage is free; your bag must be light enough that you can store it in the overhead bin unassisted with a maximum weight of 22lbs per carry-on bag.**
- Visit www.aircanada.com for more details on luggage fees. Luggage payment is paid directly to Air Canada and not included in tour package for overweight or 2nd pieces of luggage. Fees are charged on both outbound & return flights. Please be sure to read the important information section regarding Valid Passports for check-in and traveling to Europe.
- Enjoy your overnight flight. Meal included on overnight flight on aircraft.

Day 2: Tuesday, June 15 – Airport to Reykjavik, Iceland (Welcome Reception)

- This morning, we arrive at Keflavik International Airport, where you will meet your local tour manager after collecting your luggage. We then board our private motorcoach and make our way toward Reykjavik.
- Upon arrival in the city, we are welcomed by a local guide for an included orientation tour, offering a wonderful introduction to this unique and vibrant capital. **Kindly note: some walking will be required during city tours as buses are not permitted or capable of travelling through some inner-city streets.**
- Following the tour, we proceed to our centrally located city centre hotel.
- **Please note:** As we arrive in the morning, early check-in has been requested but cannot be guaranteed. Hotel rooms are typically



available later in the afternoon. Your tour manager will assist with check-in, distribute room keys, and arrange for luggage delivery once rooms are ready.

- We have scheduled a “Welcome Reception” at the hotel this evening. Enjoy some light appetizers as well as a glass of wine or beer **(included)**.
- **Please Note:** we are visiting during the approach of the summer solstice which means you experience approximately 20 hours of daylight. Sunrise is approximately 3:00am and sunset is 11:30pm.

Day 3: Wednesday, June 16 – Reykjavik, Iceland (B) ****Optional Golden Circle Tour**

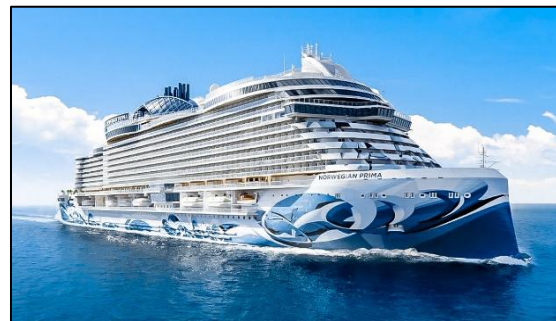
- Enjoy a delicious Icelandic hot breakfast at the hotel **(included)** before departing on our optional 7-hour “Golden Circle” Excursion.
- Our “Golden Circle” tour features the famous Thingvellir National Park located in a rift valley where the Eurasian and North American tectonic plates collide. The tour continues across breathtaking terrain until we reach Gullfoss Falls. Multiple paths take you to several vantage points.
- Next, we head to the home of “The Great Geyser” hot spring. This area offers an impressive collage of bubbling mud pools, hissing steam vents, and colourful algae deposits. Finally, enjoy the show put on by Stokkur Geyser as it blasts boiling water high into the sky every few minutes. **Lunch will be included for those participating in this optional excursion. (Price TBA).**
- Enjoy the remainder of the evening on your own. Restaurants are located within walking distance of our hotel.



Day 4: Thursday, June 17 – Reykjavik – Embarkation of Norwegian Prima (B, L, D)

****Optional Excursion to Blue Lagoon Thermal Springs**

- Enjoy another breakfast this morning at the hotel **(included)**.
- For those who wish to participate, an optional visit to the world-famous Blue Lagoon Thermal Spa offers a truly relaxing and rejuvenating experience. Set in a striking lava field, soak in the warm, mineral-rich waters while taking in the unique Icelandic landscape. Your visit includes use of a towel, a complimentary alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverage, and a signature silica mud mask. Modern changing facilities, showers, and lockers are available for your comfort before and after your time in the lagoon. **(Price TBA).**
- After our relaxing visit to the Blue Lagoon, we return to our hotel before making our way to the Reykjavik cruise pier. Your Tour Manager will assist with the embarkation process. Your luggage will be sorted and sent to your staterooms. In the meantime, take the opportunity to become familiar with this beautiful ship. Its modern design adds a unique flair to Norwegian’s already impressive fleet. Grab a bite for lunch and then make your way to your cabins to get situated before we set sail.
- Enjoy your first night aboard the Prima as you please and get ready for a thrilling adventure through some of Northern Europe’s great destinations.

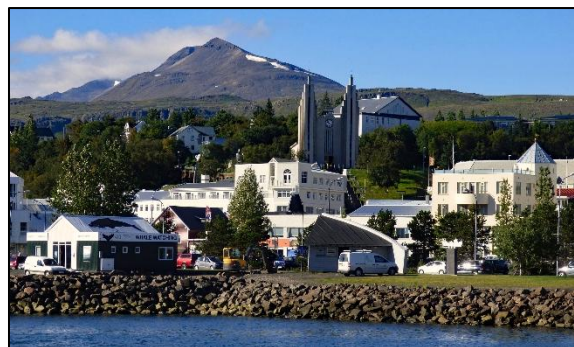


Day 5: Friday, June 18 – Isafjordur, Iceland (B, L, Cocktail Reception, D)

- Our ship is docked in Isafjordur, Iceland from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.
- Isafjordur is a town in the Westfjords region of northwest Iceland known for dramatic landscapes.
- The old town has wooden houses with corrugated tin roofs built by fishing merchants. The Westfjords Heritage Museum has exhibits on the town’s maritime history, including a collection of fishing boats.
- Enjoy taking in the stunning rugged landscapes before returning to the ship.
- Tonight, meet your Tour Manager and fellow travellers for a Collins Tours Cocktail Reception. Appetizers, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are included.

- Our ship is docked in Maløy, Norway from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Though a small coastal village of only a few thousand residents, the region surrounding Måløy is big on outdoor activities, fresh seafood and is steeped in history. From lounging on the nearly mile-long silver sand beach Refviksanden - considered one of the country's finest swimming spots - to hiking along the rugged coast and visiting picturesque lighthouses, there are numerous ways to soak in the natural beauty of Norway.

Day 10: Wednesday, June 23 – Stavanger, Norway (B, L, D) ****Optional Excursion**
