Day 1 – Sunday, Oct 31 – Flight from Canada to Tokyo, Japan

- For those who have purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Airfare & Transfers Package, you will depart Canada on your scheduled flight and meet your tour manager in a connecting airport and board our international flight. The group will clear Customs in Tokyo once you have landed.
- **NOTE: 1st checked piece of luggage is free (up to maximum of 50lbs). 2nd bag is an additional cost and based on weight. Additional fees apply for overweight and oversized bags. Carry-on luggage is free; your bag must be light enough that you can store it in the overhead bin unassisted and typical weight is maximum 22lbs per carry-on bag. Visit www.aircanada.com for more details on luggage fees. Luggage payment is paid directly to Air Canada and not included in tour package. Fees are charged on both outbound & return flights.**

Day 2 – Monday, Nov 1 – In Transit to Tokyo, Japan

- In transit by air en route to Tokyo crossing the International Date Line.
- **Arrival in Japan will take place on November 2nd.**

Day 3 – Tuesday, Nov 2 – Tokyo, Japan (B, Welcome Reception)

- Please proceed to immigration, collect luggage and meet your tour manager and fellow travellers at the baggage carousel when you arrive at Tokyo airport to board our private coach transfer to our beautiful and luxurious 5-star hotel in central Tokyo.
- Upon arriving at our hotel, your tour manager will check the group into the hotel and distribute your room key. They will also have your bag sent to your room (luggage handling fee included 1 bag per person), a signature Collins Tours service that you can expect at each hotel and cruise ship check-in during your vacation. Kindly note check-in for this hotel is not until 4:00pm local time (early check-in has been requested but not guaranteed). - Canadian citizens are required to have a valid passport that is good for at least **THREE MONTHS AFTER** your departure date. Citizens of other countries should call and verify their required documentation.
- **Baggage allowance details:** For all Air Canada flights to and from Europe: You are allowed one personal and one carry on item at no charge (max dimension: 23 cm x 40 cm x 55 cm). You are also allowed one free checked bag (max weight 23 kg; \$100 fee for overweight bag). Second checked bag is \$100 CAD each way.
- Currency used in Japan is the **Yen (JPY)**; currency used in Taiwan is the **New Taiwan Dollar (NTD)**; and currency used in Hong Kong is the **Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)**
- Duty Free Rules allow you to claim \$800 per person when you have travelled outside Canada for at least 48 hours.
- All liquids and gels that you are planning to bring on board an airplane must be 3oz or less and sealed in a Ziploc bag and kept in your carry-on. Keep prescription medication in original container or carried with you.
- Collins Tour is not responsible for lost or stolen baggage and/or personal items.
